INVESTMENT STRATEGY

The Global Impact Disruptive Innovation Strategy aims for long-term capital growth by actively managing a concentrated portfolio of public equity securities of companies that are relevant to the theme of disruptive innovation. The portfolio represents ARK's highest-conviction investment ideas in the areas of DNA Sequencing, Autonomous Technology, Energy Storage, Deep Learning, Fintech, and Robotics.

The strategy invests in what ARK believes are the leaders, enablers, and beneficiaries of disruptive technologies. The strategy is benchmark agnostic. It will invest in companies across multiple sectors and geographies. Portfolios will include issuers across all market capitalizations with low overlap to traditional broad market indices.

The strategy is driven by ARK's unique research process, which incorporates an open research architecture ("Open Research Ecosystem") designed to gain a deeper understanding of technology to identify disruptive innovation early.

WHY INVEST IN ARK'S STRATEGY?

- Exposure to Innovation: Aims for thematic multi-cap exposure across sectors to disruptive
 areas of innovation.
- **2. Growth Potential:** Aims to capture long-term growth with low correlation of relative returns to traditional growth strategies and negative correlation to value strategies.
- **3. Tool for Diversification:** Offers a tool for diversification due to little overlap with traditional indices and can serve as a complement to traditional strategies.
- **4. Grounded in Research:** Combines top-down and bottom-up research in its portfolio management to identify innovative companies and convergence across markets.

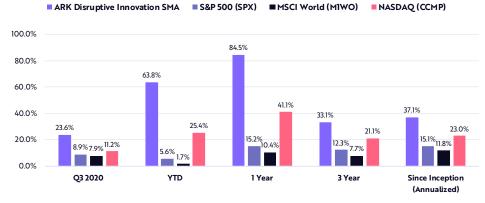
